CVS Pharmacy has successfully operated at this location since 1999 and has more than 5 years remaining on their primary lease term. The lease features ten 5-year renewal option periods. CVS Pharmacy is an investment grade rated company (S&P: BBB+) and publicly traded on the New York Stock Exchange using symbol "CVS".

The 10,159 square foot CVS Pharmacy is strategically positioned at the signalized intersection of Monticello Boulevard and Noble Road, two primary thoroughfares in the trade area with a combined traffic count exceeding 36,480 vehicles per day. The property is in a densely populated residential area with over 132,000 people living within a three mile radius of the property.










Cleveland Heights, Ohio

Cleveland Heights is a city in Cuyahoga County, Ohio and an inner-ring suburb of Cleveland. The city's has a population of more than 46,120 people. As of the 2010 census, Cleveland Heights was ranked the 8th largest city by population in the Greater Cleveland metropolitan area and ranked 20th in Ohio.



The area that is now Cleveland Heights was settled later than most of Cuyahoga County. The first road through what is today the city, Mayfield Road, was not built until 1828. Besides farms the area also had quarries in the 19th century. One of the early quarries was established by Duncan McFarland and mined bluestone. This led to the settlement that grew up around the quarry for the workers to live in to be referred to as Bluestone. Cleveland Heights was officially founded as a village in 1903 and a city in 1921.

Cleveland is a city in the state of Ohio and is the county seat of Cuyahoga County, the most populous county in the state. The city is located in northeastern Ohio on the southern shore of Lake Erie, approximately 60 miles west of the Pennsylvania border. Cleveland's economy has diversified sectors that include manufacturing, financial services, healthcare, and biomedical. Cleveland is home to the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Cleveland is part of the larger Cleveland-Akron-Canton, OH Combined Statistical Area, which has a population in excess of 3,500,000 people, and ranked as the country's 15th largest CSA.

Cleveland is home to the corporate headquarters of many large companies such as Applied Industrial Technologies, Cliffs Natural Resources, Forest City Enterprises, NACCO Industries, Sherwin-Williams Company and KeyCorp. NASA maintains a facility in Cleveland, the Glenn Research Center. Jones Day, one of the largest law firms in the U.S, began in Cleveland. Cleveland Hopkins International Airport is the city's major airport and an international airport that formerly served as a main hub for United Airlines. It holds the distinction of having the first airport-to-downtown rapid transit connection in North America, established in 1968. The Port of Cleveland, located at the Cuyahoga River's mouth, is a major bulk freight terminal on Lake Erie, receiving much of the raw materials used by the region's manufacturing industries.
