


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Boulder Group is pleased to exclusively market for sale a single tenant net leased Rite Aid Pharmacy located in Pottstown Pennsylvania, roughly 35 miles northwest of Philadelphia. The Rite Aid Pharmacy is strategically positioned at the corner of a signalized intersection. The property features a drive-thru, GNC in-store outlet and has excellent visibility and signage. Rite Aid Pharmacy has successfully operated at this location since 1998 and recently underwent interior renovations that transformed the original store format into Rite Aid's new and improved "Wellness" themed format. There are more than 3 years remaining on the lease that features two 5-year renewal option periods. Rite Aid Pharmacy is one of the nation's leading drugstore chains and the largest drugstore chain on the East Coast.

The 10,752 square foot Rite Aid Pharmacy is strategically positioned at the signalized intersection of High Street and Evans Street. High Street is a primary thoroughfare in the area providing interchangeable access to Pottstown Pike (PA-100) which experiences traffic counts in excess of 64,000 vehicles per day. The property is located in downtown Pottstown along the town's main retail corridor within close proximity to local businesses, restaurants, shops and schools. National retailers in the immediate area include AutoZone, Wells Fargo Bank, BB&T and Sherwin-Williams. There are more than 48,000 people living within a three mile radius of the property earning an average household income of \$77,315 per year.










Pottstown *

Pottstown, Pennsylvania

Pottstown is a borough in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, roughly 35 miles northwest of Philadelphia on the Schuylkill River. Pottstown has a population of over 22,375 people. Pottstown was laid out in 1752 and named Pottsgrove in honor of its founder, John Potts. The old name was abandoned at the time of the incorporation as a borough in 1815. In 1888, the limits of the borough were considerably extended. Pottstown is the center of a productive farming and dairying region.

The main east-west street in Pottstown is High Street, which continues east of the borough as Ridge Pike. The main north-south street in the borough is Hanover Street. The U.S. Route 422 freeway passes to the south of Pottstown and heads east to King of Prussia and Philadelphia and west to Reading. Pennsylvania Route 100 runs north-south through the Pottstown area, heading south to West Chester and north to Allentown. Pennsylvania Route 663 begins at PA 100 in Pottstown and follows King Street east and Charlotte Street northeast before leaving the borough and continuing to Pennsburg and Quakertown. Pennsylvania Route 724 runs along the south bank of the Schuylkill River in Chester County. Pottstown is serviced by Pottstown Municipal Airport, a general aviation airport, and a short distance from Pottstown is Heritage Field Airport located in Limerick.

MARKET OVERVIEW:

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Philadelphia is the largest city in Pennsylvania and the sixth-most populous city in the United States, with an estimated population of more than 1,568,000 and more than 6 million in the seventh-largest metropolitan statistical area. Philadelphia is the economic and cultural anchor of the Delaware Valley—a region located in the Northeastern United States at the confluence of the Delaware and Schuylkill Rivers with 7.2 million people residing in the eighth-largest combined statistical area in the United States.

In 1682, William Penn, an English Quaker, founded the city to serve as capital of the Pennsylvania Colony. Philadelphia played an instrumental role in the American Revolution as a meeting place for the Founding Fathers of the United States, who signed the Declaration of Independence in 1776 and the Constitution in 1787. Several other key Philadelphia events during the Revolution include the First and Second Continental Congress, the preservation of the Liberty Bell, the Battle of Germantown, the Siege of Fort Mifflin, and the Philadelphia Convention. Philadelphia was one of the nation's capitals in the Revolutionary War, and served as temporary U.S. capital while Washington, D.C., was under construction

The area's many universities and colleges make Philadelphia a top international study destination, as the city has evolved into an educational and economic hub. With a gross domestic product of \$388 billion, Philadelphia ranks ninth among world cities and fourth in the nation. Philadelphia is the center of economic activity in Pennsylvania and is home to seven Fortune 1000 companies.

Two airports serve Philadelphia: the Philadelphia International Airport (PHL), straddling the southern boundary of the city, and the Northeast Philadelphia Airport (PNE), a general aviation reliever airport in Northeast Philadelphia. Philadelphia International Airport provides scheduled domestic and international air service, while Northeast Philadelphia Airport serves general and corporate aviation. In 2013, Philadelphia International Airport was the 15th busiest airport in the world measured by traffic movements (i.e. takeoffs and landings). It is also the second largest hub and primary international hub for American Airlines.

Philadelphia is the birthplace of the United States Marine Corps, and is also the home of many U.S. firsts, including the first library (1731), first hospital (1751) and medical school (1765), first Capital (1777), first stock exchange (1790), first zoo (1874), and first business school (1881). Philadelphia is the only World Heritage City in the United States.
